LIBRARY CLASSIFICATION > AKA how books are labeled

The libraries use a modified version of the Dewey Decimal System. This ascending numerical system organizes books into 10 subjects and its subdivisions, and makes it possible to create a unique call number:

000 Generalities

100 Philosophy & Psychology

200 Religion

300 Social Sciences

400 Languages

500 Natural Science & Mathematics

600 Technology (Applied Sciences)

700 Arts

800 Literature

900 Geography & History


LIBRARY CLASSIFICATION The Call Number

Each book has a unique Call Number attached to the spine of the book. This label helps place it in a particular location on the shelves. You can find it by a search of the library's online catalog.

I.e., The textbook Business Ethics, 9th edition, by William Shaw has the following call number:

174.4	Dewey number for subject
S47b	Capital S - 1st letter of author's last name; 47 numerical representation of the rest of the author's name; lower case b – 1st letter of the title of the book
2017	Year published
9e	Edition




